



Job title	<i>Pavement Marking Driver/Operator – Long line Crew</i>

Job purpose

Drive and operate, and maintain longline road striping equipment.

Duties and responsibilities

- Layout and install pavement markings of various types.
- Perform maintenance on pavement marking equipment.
- Properly store and handle pavement marking materials.
- Keep equipment and work areas clean and in good appearance.
- Be able to react to change positively and productively and handle other essential tasks as assigned.
- Be knowledgeable and proficient in driving and or operating long line highway striping equipment.
- You must also know how to do daily routine maintenance and troubleshooting on this equipment. The equipment may be thermoplastic or paint striping equipment. It also can include removal equipment and roadway sweepers.

Qualifications

Qualifications include:

- Obtain and maintain a valid Texas drivers' license. A Class A or B CDL is necessary.
- Previous experience in highway construction or pavement markings is an asset.
- Abilities – Ability to learn multiple tasks involved with this type of work. Types of work include layout of various types of roadways. This job primarily involves the use of striping trucks and mobile operations. You will also assist other crews when needed.
- Must be able to be on your feet for hours at a time to perform layout. Previous experience is helpful but training will be provided.

Working conditions

Working environment includes being in close proximity to traffic, construction equipment and other work operations nearby. Working outdoors in extreme weather conditions and for long hours at a time is usual for this job. The job entails day and night work as well as weekends. You will also work and stay out of town overnight.

Physical requirements

You must be able to drive/sit and stay alert for extended periods of time. You must be able to lift 50 lbs to shoulder height repetitively. You must be able to recognize hazards and communicate these to your fellow crew members. You must have good hand and eye coordination and maintain good communication with your crew members as to what is coming up ahead and what your actions will be.
